



Dr. Mohamed Abdel Aziz Abdel Rahman as the new CEO

Of the Egyptian Electric Utility and Consumer Protection Regulatory Agency

His excellency the Prime Minister Dr. Mostafa Madbouly has issued a Decree appointing Dr. Mohamed Abdel Aziz Abdel Rahman as the Executive Chairman of the Egyptian Electric Utility and Consumer Protection Regulatory Agency effective February 1, 2019.

Dr. Mohamed Abdel Aziz, is a professor of electrical power systems in the Department of Electrical Power and Machinery at the Faculty of Engineering, Ain Shams University. He has also held several senior executive and consulting positions, most notably as an engineering consultant in the Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development.

Prior to that, Dr. Abdel Rahman served as a consultant to the Egyptian Electric Utility and Consumer Protection Regulatory Agency for the period 2002-2013, in addition to serving as an energy consultant in NEPAD Secretariat of the African Union.

Dr. Abdel Rahman holds a BSc in Electrical Systems Engineering from Ain Shams University. He has received a Master's and PHD degree from the University of Toronto, Canada, as well as an MBA in Banking and Finance from the University of Maastricht, Holland. He has also published many research papers in international and local journals/conferences and supervised 25 masters and PHD dissertations.

The Egyptian Electric Utility and Consumer Protection Regulatory Agency is the only electricity regulator in Egypt, which is responsible for regulating and monitoring all activities related to electrical energy activity in generation, transmission, distribution and consumption to ensure availability and sustainability in meeting the requirements of different uses at the most appropriate prices while preserving the environment. Among the mandates of the Agency protecting the electricity consumers and issuing the electricity tariff for the Arab Republic of Egypt. The Agency also grants permits and licenses for the activities of electricity generation and distribution, as well as providing competitive environment and avoiding any monopolistic situation.
