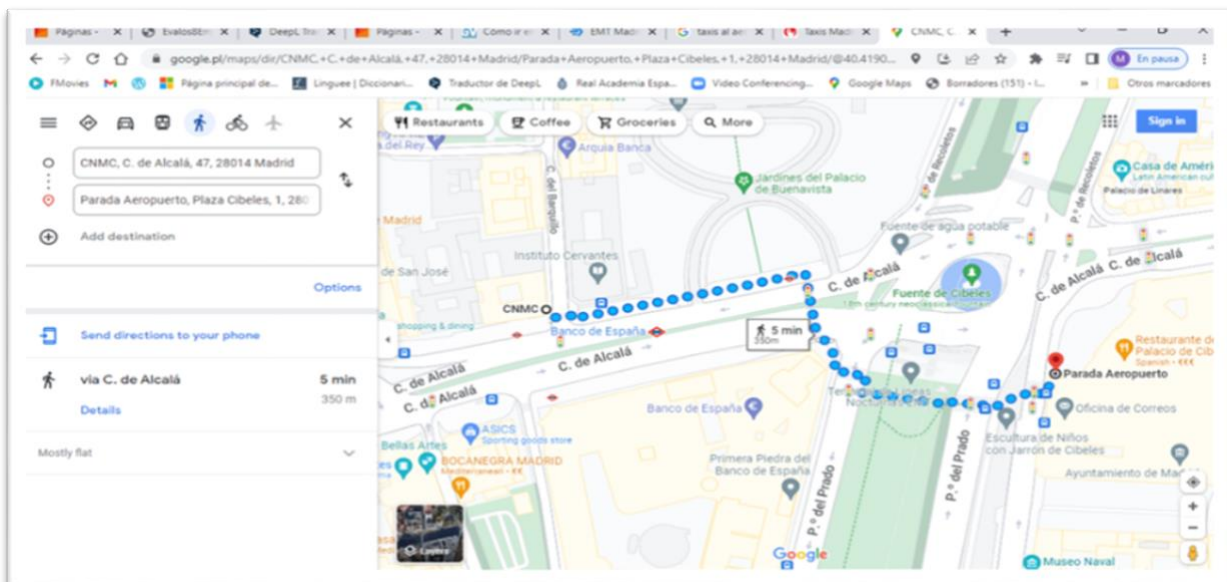

TRANSPORTATION

By taxi. The fare is fixed at **33 euros** (plus luggage, if applicable) for a ride from the airport (Madrid Barajas) to the city centre. When arriving at the airport, please follow the indications for taxi. From CNMC to the airport, taxis are available directly on the street or th service can be arranged at a taxi company (e.g; taxi Madrid Independiente: 914051213 ; [radiotaxi](#): 915478200/915478500 or through the online app [pidetaxi.es](#); [teletaxi](#): 913712131).



By bus. Information is available [here](#). The trip takes between 30 and 40 minutes. The bus stops at Atocha (the main train station) and **Cibeles square** (5-min walk from CNMC premises). The journey costs a flat-rate of **5 euros**, and it can be paid directly to the driver in cash (no more than a 20-euro bill is allowed), by bank card, or with a mobile device. The bus

runs **every 15-20 minutes**, from 6 am to 11.30 pm, and every 35 minutes from 11.30 pm to 6 am.

SOCIAL PROGRAMME

CNMC and MEDREG have envisaged a social programme in the margins of the main meetings, namely:

- A technical visit to the control centre of REE, Spanish TSO (177, Paseo del Conde de los Gaitanes, Alcobendas) on 26 November afternoon
- An informal dinner kindly offered by MEDREG on 26 November
- A guided visit to the Prado Museum on 27 November (from 6 PM to 8 PM)
- An official dinner and flamenco show, kindly offered by CNMC on 27 November (at 9 PM)

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The currency in Spain is the Euro (EUR), abbreviated as €.

For the best rates, make sure to exchange currency during weekdays, within working hours (10:00 - 21:00). Credit cards are widely accepted at most hotels, restaurants, tourist shops, and supermarkets. However, it's advisable to always carry a small amount of cash with you, while staying cautious of pickpockets in crowded public areas. When booking accommodation, it's recommended to check directly with the hotel to confirm which payment methods they accept.

SECURITY INFORMATION

Participants are asked to take the normal precautions when travelling abroad. Keep your valuables in the hotel safe, and ensure that you do not carry your money, credit cards and travel documents conspicuously.

WEATHER INFORMATION and LOCAL TIME

In Madrid, during the month of November, the weather is generally cool. Average daytime temperatures range between 13 and 16°C, while nighttime temperatures typically drop to around 6 to 8°C, which can feel quite chilly, particularly if it's windy. Although sunny days are still common, November is generally one of the rainiest months of the year.

To remain comfortable in these conditions, it is advisable to wear a coat and winter clothes.
